


106 Advanced Seminar: Albuquerque, NM

“The Section 106 Advanced Seminar” will be held on Thursday, August 21, 2014

Important note: Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of registrations received with payment at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

Registration: Payment may be made by on-line credit card registration or by check or SF 182. Go to: <http://www.achp.gov/106essentials.html> to register.

Course Location and Accommodations: The course is being held in the Franciscan Ballroom at the Hotel Albuquerque at Old Town, 800 Rio Grande Blvd NW. (<http://www.hotelabq.com/albuquerque-new-mexico-hotel.aspx>). A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees August 18-20 at the government rate of \$81 for a single occupancy plus applicable state and local tax (13%). **It is recommended that you make your reservations early, as the rooms are likely to sell out. Reservations must be made by July 28.** Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. **To reserve your room**, call the reservation department at 505-843-6300 or toll free at 800-237-2133 and ask to be connected to reservations. To receive the group rate, guests must state that they would like to be placed within the “ACHP Section 106 Historic Preservation” block of rooms (or they may refer to the Block Code 1408ACHPSE).

Hotel and Local Information: In the heart of Old Town, the Hotel Albuquerque offers a unique destination in the midst of the historic district located. Old Town Albuquerque, New Mexico was constructed around a central plaza and features historic buildings dating back to the 1700s. Visit the San Felipe de Neri Church, which was built in 1793, and see attractions along the 10 lovely blocks of Old Town and check out museums, art galleries, boutiques and authentic southwest restaurants. Registration: Registration will be located outside the conference room on Thursday at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

Schedule: *The Section 106 Seminar* runs from 8:30 a.m. to approximately 4:30 p.m. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon with a longer break for lunch.

Meals: Light morning fare and an afternoon snack are provided. The cost of this food is included in your registration fee. All other meals are on your own.

Attire for Training Course: Attire for the course is casual. Also, please keep in mind that hotel meeting rooms tend to be cool, so plan to bring a sweater or jacket.

Cancellations: Registrants who cancel at least 14 days prior to the start of the course will receive a full refund minus a 15% processing fee. No refunds will be given for cancellations made fewer than 14 days before the start of the course; however, substitutions may be made at no cost up until three days before the course begins. All cancellations must be made in writing.
